Easter Egg Hunt- March 31st @ 11:00 AM


Bring your Easter Egg Basket and join us on the front lawn following worship for our Easter Egg Hunt! You won't want to miss out!

BASKET BONANZA - COMING SOON

We are in the final stages of assembling gift baskets with "Goodies" for Basket Bonanza which will be held on Thursday, March 7, Friday, March 8, and Saturday, March 9. We currently have completed 242 baskets and are working to complete a few more using the supplies we have in the Missions Room. This project will replace the Spring Rummage Sale as a fundraiser. Proceeds from the Basket Bonanza will go to Foundation 2 Mental Health and Waypoint Housing Services.

Foundation 2 was founded in Cedar Rapids in 1970 and focuses on crisis prevention and intervention for people of all ages. Today, they support people across Iowa in crisis approximately 100,000 times per year. They are committed to positive youth development, suicide prevention and helping build the foundation for stronger and safer communities for everyone.

Waypoint Housing Services is a leader in helping end homelessness through multiple best practice, cuttingedge services. They support Madge Phillips Center Shelter, using Centralized Intake, Coordinated Entry, Rapid Re-Housing, Homeless Prevention Services, Tenant Academy and Balance of the State Call Center. On any given day there are 2,749 people who are homeless in Iowa as reported by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
